Exhibitors should carry the original valid official Jump Height Card at each trial to present upon request. It is no longer necessary to include your height card with your entry. Entries that are missing classes or incomplete will be returned. Per the new rules, you do not need to attach jump height cards. Please check off the appropriate box on the new entry regarding cards.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

- The site will be open for **crating Friday, April 16th (5pm-7:30 pm)**. No dogs will be permitted to remain in the building overnight. Do not arrive early, the barn is in use.
- **RV Overnight parking permitted.\$25.00 per night. Registration required. Self-contained units only. No hookups. MUST Pre-Register.**
- The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that **their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.**
- Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.
- **Please note this trial is limited to 330 runs/day. This trial opens 2/15/10 at 9 am and closes 4/02/10 at 5 PM. Opening Period for Golden Retrievers only from 9 AM, 2/15/10 to 2/24/10. Entries for ALL OTHER AKC BREEDS open 9 AM, 2/25/10**
- **NO HAND DELIVERIES.** Express mail entries must include **signature waiver** permitting them to be left at the secretary's address with recipient's signature. Limit per envelope: 10 dogs' entries.
- **Bitches in season** shall not be eligible to participate. There will be a refund of entries due to bitches in season after trial has closed. A veterinarian's note must accompany any such refund request minus an administration fee of \$10.00 per day.
- **Entry fees will not be refunded** in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee.
- **Checks** not honored by the bank do not constitute a valid entry. There will be a \$30 service charge for bank returned checks.
- Owners are responsible for all **errors on entry forms** and no entry fee will be refunded in the event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date.
- Exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Show Committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made.
- No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.
- All dogs must be on leash at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm-up area.
- Exhibitors are responsible for being at the ring gate when it is their turn to run.
- **Food** will be available on site with Wings & Things.
- **NEW ENTRY FORM** must be used. The old entry forms you have will not be accepted since there were changes to the AKC Form

Classes Offered

ENTRY FEE: \$25.00 for the first entry of each dog. \$14.00 for an additional entry for the same dog each day. (Includes \$3.00 AKC recording fee per run.)

Novice Agility Class (Novice A, B, P)

The Novice Agility class is divided into Division A for persons and dogs that have never acquired an agility title, Division B for dogs that have acquired the Novice Agility title, persons that have handled a dog to an agility title, and for agility Judges, and Novice P (Preferred) which is open to handlers of all levels and dogs starting in the Preferred program even if they have upper level regular agility titles.

Open Agility Class (Regular or Preferred)

Open to dogs that have acquired the Novice Agility or Open Agility title but which have not acquired the Agility Excellent title.

Excellent Agility Class (Regular or Preferred)

The Excellent Agility Class is divided into Division A for persons and dogs that have completed the Open Agility title but not the Agility Excellent title and Division B for dogs that have acquired the Agility Excellent title or the Master Agility Excellent title.

Jumpers With Weaves:

Agility classes are divided into Novice A, B and Preferred, Open and Open Preferred, and Excellent A, B and Excellent A & B Preferred. All classes are offered following the same eligibility rules as the standard classes.

Height Divisions

Owners/Agents are responsible for entering the proper height divisions. All height divisions will be offered in both the standard classes and the jumpers with weaves classes. Dogs in the preferred classes must jump their measured height since they are not allowed to jump in a higher height as dogs in the regular classes are. If you are unsure of your height or your dog is borderline and you don't have a height card please enter the lower height and if necessary the judge will move you up.

Prizes and Awards

Rosettes will be awarded to the 1st through 4th place dog in each jump height in each class. All qualifiers will receive a dog toy valued at \$5.00 or under and a qualifying ribbon. All ribbons/rosettes must be claimed at the trial. None will be mailed.

High Scoring Golden Retriever in each Standard and Jumpers class –Golden Retriever related prize valued at \$15 or under.

PAX and MACH Ribbons will be awarded to those dogs completing their titles.

A MACH Bar will be presented to those completing their title.

New Title Ribbons are available. All prizes, awards, rosettes & ribbons must be claimed the day of the trial. No prizes will be mailed.

Dogs Eligible to Enter

This trial is open to all dogs 15 months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or have AKC Limited Registration or are of a registerable breed that has obtained an AKC ILP number.

Dogs of a registerable breed with an acceptable foreign registration number are eligible to participate subject to Chap.11, Sec. 1 of the Dog Show Rules. Mixed breeds, breeds not registerable with the AKC, bitches in season, aggressive dogs, blind or deaf dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance are not eligible to participate. No dog shall compete if it is taped or bandaged or in any way has anything attached to it for medical purposes. Spayed bitches and neutered males are eligible to participate.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases and have appropriate vaccinations.

Course Familiarization and Warm-Ups

Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, prior to the start of the class. The walk-through allows handlers to plan their strategy for running the course. A walk-through period will be held prior to each class. No umbrellas are allowed during walk-thrus.

A warm-up area consisting of a regulation agility jump, shall be provided for all exhibitors.

Directions to Silent Farm

From the South and East: Take NY State Thruway to Exit 16 Harriman. After the toll stay on Route 17 to exit 124 Goshen. Go left at first traffic light and right at the next light onto Route 207 East toward Goshen. Follow Route 207 into Goshen and at the traffic light at the cubist Orange County Building, go left onto Scotchtown Avenue. Proceed 1-1/4 miles, to Axworthy Lane on left side, see the sign for Silent Farm. Follow Axworthy Lane around bend to Silent Farm on your left. Please follow parking instructions.

INSTRUCTIONS

Handlers may opt to enter in a higher height division for all Regular titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs entered in the Preferred classes must compete at the required jump height and may not compete in a jump height division higher or lower than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an **Agility Jump Height Card** may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial or *back-to-back trials* only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Mixed breed classes may only be offered at standalone all-breed AKC agility trials. A standalone agility event is defined as an agility trial that is not held on the same date and show site as an AKC All-Breed Dog Show or Independent Specialty for conformation. Dogs entered in the mixed breed classes must list the breed name as "mixed breed" and not as a breed hybrid.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 816-3776. If the Junior Handler is not the owner of the dog identified on the face of this form, what is the relationship of the Junior Handler to the Owner?
